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CURRICULUM SUBJECT SYLLABUS 2022 – 2023

Introduction.

We will enable the realization of the purpose and objectives of the study program of the Professional College of Police Training for public order and security with the development of a series of subjects, which are represented by syllabi as a summary or substantial part of the curriculum of each subject . More specifically, the syllabi for two main groups of subjects are presented: for the subjects and modules categorized in the "General Training" group, as well as for the "Professional Training" subjects and modules.

- a. The subjects and modules that belong to the general university education, as the group of teaching disciplines that give a general character to the study program, in the teaching-academic plan consist of 5 subjects and occupy about 50% of the total number.
- b. Vocational training subjects, as a group of teaching disciplines that give a special character to the entire study program, in the teaching-academic plan, consist of 4 subjects as well as professional practice at the end of the academic year, which together account for about 50% of the total number.

These syllabuses reflect the data related to the content of the course, its teaching load (lectures, seminars, practical work, etc.), the organization of training activities and the requirements for the preparation of the course (attendance, exam preparation, professional practice, etc.), the expected professional knowledge, skills and competences, the recommended literature, as well as the way of evaluating students.

SYLLABUS OF GENERAL EDUCATION SUBJECTS

"General Education" subjects and modules

The general training subjects, as the group of teaching disciplines aimed at the general training of police officers of the basic role of the "General Patrol" profile, in the teaching-academic plan, consist of 5 subjects and occupy about 50% of the total number of the subjects it contains. Meanwhile, ECTS credits are as much as 23.33% of the credits of the entire study program of the Higher Professional College for public order and security. On the other hand, the amount of hours determined for general education courses is 350 hours, or about 22.58% of the total hours of the entire academic year of studies. More concret:

SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

- It is a subject of a theoretical-practical character that is developed with the students of the "General Patrol" course to receive basic police education, to know police legislation in the Legal, Sociological, Police services for Public Safety, Road, Prevention of Crimes and Border and Migration Police.
- The subject offers education that will form and develop disciplined police officers, with full professional knowledge and skills, capable of serving the community, to guarantee public order and security, while simultaneously recognizing and respecting basic human rights and freedoms, based on the principles of democratic policing.

Description of the subject

- The course deals with topics related to the powers of the Order, Criminal, Road, Border and Migration Police, which are mainly related to the legislation that assigns tasks to the "General Patrol", in the State Police, as well as topics related to the operation of these services.
- Explains the principles of the State Police regarding harassment, racism, discrimination against gender or ethnic bias of any kind, information procedures and possible disciplinary actions that must be taken according to the principles and procedure of the State Police, reflected in the State Police Regulations.
- The subject explains the obligations of the police according to the law of the State Police,

- as well as the duties and rights according to the Code of Criminal Procedure (C.Pr.P).
- The general principles of the arrest and detention of minors/adults according to the legal provisions, the powers of the police to arrest minors/adults and the conditions that must be met for the establishment of the security measure of detention in prison for minors/adults.
- The procedures that police officers must follow in relation to the actions they must perform for the practical demonstration at a scene.
- The subject is oriented towards the participants and is based on: class discussions, group/individual work, practical exercises and role-playing related to example events.
- Written evaluation, test through the "Scantron" system.
- Practical assessment

The course aims to provide knowledge on:

- The basic legislation in the performance of the functional duties of police officers for "General Patrol.
- The basic tasks of the police in the field of order and public safety
- Cooperation of knowledge expressed by topics in the professional field and general education.
- Basic opportunities for professional police education.
- Descriptions of the qualification requirements of employees, capable of serving all types of services in the field of security.
- Teaching topics in the field of Law, Sociology, Psychology, Communication, Crime Prevention and Investigation, Public Security and State Border Management.
- Road traffic rules, norms of behavior for road users.
- Theoretical bases of the events created by the criminal offenses and the measures taken by the police officers of the basic role.
- The means and technical equipment available to the police in carrying out their duties.
- Techniques for performing functional tasks and safety rules for police officers during activities such as: gatherings, demonstrations, sports, cultural, religious activities, etc.
- The procedure followed for ascertaining, examining and executing the sanction for the administrative offence.
- The documentation that is drawn up for accompanying persons and completing the accompanying form. (practical actions).
- Integrated Border Management (MIK), the principles and standards of control of the EU countries.

At the end of the course, the trainees will be able to:

- To learn and implement the responsibilities of the police officer to protect the freedoms and rights of citizens and to enforce the laws.
- To manage to show an authority of law enforcement, as a frontline service in daily contact with citizens, to create a positive perception among the public. (Acquiring good knowledge about legislation, about general procedures, about the road code, about the basics of the investigation, about the criminal procedure, about the collection and preservation of the evidence that speaks of a criminal offense, about the management of incidents, etc., are in function of achieving this objective).
- To provide and demonstrate skills in sound judgment and decision-making, based on the required ethics and values, to enable the first intervention in adaptation to the environment, circumstances, often sensitive for the community and different groups such as minors, victims of criminal events, etc.
- To acquire skills and practical professional skills to cope with and provide solutions and

- answers to typical situations, with proven techniques, both to protect citizens and to serve them.
- These skills include the use of equipment, communication, self-driving, conducting research, as well as first intervention in any situation.
